

We are very excited to offer STEAM camp to our upcoming sixth graders. STEAM camp gives these students the opportunity to dive deeper into the outlined topics. The following section details the exciting activities we have planned for this year's camp, "My Coastal Backyard."

"The Cutting Edge" In this jaw-dropping experience, students will learn the ins and outs of the ocean's most deadly predators. "Totally Turtle" Students will investigate sea turtle types, life cycles, habitats, and dangers in our oceans. Students will enjoy an art project and more!

### "Respect the Locals: Home for the

Manatee" Students will use a wide variety of sustainable materials to create a cozy 3-D marsh environment, complete with sand, shells and marsh grasses. And who will inhabit this delightful diorama? The gentlest of giants, the coastal local, the manatee!

### "Cierra la pantalla, vamos a la playa" (Close your screen; let's go to the beach)

Students will explore the Spanish language and culture through music, food and vocabulary activities related to the other STEAM lessons.

"Avian Avengers" Students will learn all about birds, including how to identify the 10 most common birds in our area, why bird species are experiencing a significant decline, creating a bird feeder, and learning how they can become superheroes for the birds in their own backyard.

"Agricultural Explorations" Explore the world of agriculture as you interact with goats, rabbits, guinea pigs, chickens & more. We will learn about the processes of evaluating poultry/livestock & explore the value of pollinators to our food supply; enjoy some cooking encounters along the way.

Sea Shells by the Sea Shore Have you ever wondered about coastal critters that live in the sea? In this class, students will learn about characteristics of gastropods and bivalves from southeast Georgia. Emphasis will be placed on features of their shells, identification, impact on the environment, and even creating art with shells.
