

Self Serve Password Portal


Camden County Schools now has a self service password portal which will allow all staff and students to reset their own network password (and Google password) without entering a SchoolDude or calling the technology department.

This works the same as many of your bank or retail accounts. You must first register your account and answer some challenge questions in the portal. When you need to reset your password you can access the portal from any computer and reset it using the challenge questions or by having info sent to a personal e-mail account or cell phone.



If you wish to register a cell phone, Click on the Multi Factor Settings tab, then click Add new phone . Add your cell phone number and select your provider. You will be sent a one time password that has to be entered to complete the registration.



Once this is complete you can access the portal under the staff tab of the district web page and reset your password from any computer or web enabled phone.

Please remember that resetting your network password will also reset your Google password.
